CALLER: Somebody (inaudible) the apartment and somebody was shot through my apartment and I think it's the neighbor across the hall from me. He just shot through...

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: There's a bullet hole through my apartment.

OPERATOR: Did anybody get hit?

CALLER: I, I got grazed a little bit. It went straight through my wall.

OPERATOR: Okay do you have any kind of, any bleeding going on?

CALLER: No, nope I mean, um no...

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: No, no.

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: I don't know if I should shoot back. I have license to carry...

OPERATOR: I would not recommend that. We're getting an officer out there as fast as we can. If you keep your gun put away it'll make it more clear to the officers where, ah the shots are coming from and where they're going towards. (Inaudible)...

CALLER: (Inaudible) apartment, it's across the hall literally. I know that guy does not like me. For some odd reason he's been stalking me and I think (inaudible) a stalker cause he's the only one who could do that.

OPERATOR: Okay and it was coming from that direction? That's where the bullet...

CALLER: Yes, it literally went straight through the wall, it was two shots. I have kids, two,

CALLER: And, and the thing is I can't let you guys in the building cause I have to go downstairs, all the way downstairs to let you guys in.

OPERATOR: Okay, there's no buzzer or anything like that?

CALLER: No the buzzers don't work.

OPERATOR: Okay, okay. Ah we'll, we'll get some, we'll find a way to get somebody in there.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Just let us know if, ah stay on the line with me. I'm just, I'm just typing out that message that you are unable to go downstairs, just one second here.

CALLER: Okay, I'm hugging my (inaudible) I don't know if he's gonna die, oh my God.

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: No (inaudible) stay on the ground, stay on the ground.

OPERATOR: We have help on the way.

CHILD'S VOICE: (Inaudible).

CALLER TALKING TO CHILD: Just stay on the ground baby, stay over here.

OPERATOR: Okay, and so, so you say it, you, you said it might have grazed you?

CALLER: It, it was, it was like I'm, I'm looking at my shoulder, like my chest. I, I don't know if the bullet hit me or if it was like, glass that hit me cause it went through my wall and it hit, like a glass vase on my table. I was in the kitchen...

OPERATOR: Okay, do you need medical attention?

CALLER: Um, no. I'm not like, I'm not like bleeding or anything. It (inaudible).

OPERATOR: Okay, yeah we have help on the way right now. Ah they're, they're at 24<sup>th</sup> right now. They're very close by, they just have to go a couple of blocks. Ah, what is your name while you're here with me.

CALLER: AREBELLA. (sp?)

OPERATOR: What's your last name?

CALLER: (inaudible last name).

OPERATOR: And what's your phone number?

CALLER: 13.82

**OPERATOR:** Mm-hmm. (affirmative)

CALLER: 13.82

**OPERATOR:** Mm-hmm. (affirmative)

CALLER: 13.82

OPERATOR: I have **13.82** Is that correct?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: Okay, ah do you know the name of the neighbor that might have done this?

CALLER: No, but it's apartment 318. He lives right, right literally right across (inaudible).

OPERATOR: Okay, can I get a description of that possible suspect? Is he Black, White, Hispanic, Native American?

CALLER: He's small and short and he's Black. He (inaudible), he's like 4, like (inaudible).

CALLER: He's, he's been having issues with me and like, stalking me cause I won't give him attention and I, I don't know if he's been upset lately and just wanted to shoot through. I don't know if he shot his self, I don't know what's going on but I literally heard two bullets, like two shots go off and I, I, I didn't hear nobody in the hallway but you have to get, like two, a metal door to get through the hallway and I didn't hear nobody open the door so it had to be somebody on this floor.

**OPERATOR:** Okay.

CALLER: I'm sorry if I was (inaudible)...

## OPERATOR: No.

CALLER: I was just making dinner and...

OPERATOR: Yeah, of course you should be. This is very reasonable given the circumstances that you're in, you're doing just fine here, thank you so much for calling us. Um, about how old would you say the guy across the hall is?

CALLER: I would say just like, late um, maybe late twenties, early thirties.

## OPERATOR: Okay, and do you remember what kind of hair he has?

CALLER: Um, he has the (inaudible), like a doo rag on, or like a, a wrap around his head so, but I think he has short hair.

OPERATOR: Okay. Okay, they've got folks outside of your apartment building right now. They're trying to figure out how, they're, they're trying to get in (inaudible).

CALLER: Can I...

OPERATOR: They'll figure it out.

CALLER: (Inaudible) should I (inaudible) run down there?

OPERATOR: Um if you, if you don't feel safe to do so, don't do so. We're, they're...

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Gonna get in however they can. Um if you, if you do feel safe you, you always are welcome but I don't recommend doing anything you do not feel safe doing.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Um, um can you tell me, ah so you say that, did, did one bullet go into your house or did two?

CALLER: I, I only see one cause it went right through the kitchen. I don't know where the other one is.

OPERATOR: Okay. Okay, okay we have folks outside right now.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Um they're just, ah I think they might be gathering to, to make sure they have enough of them. They might be trying to find their way in, I don't know for sure. Um would you, do you, do you see or hear anything else right now?

CALLER: Yes, I think someone's trying to break in, I don't know.

OPERATOR: What are you hearing at your door?

CALLER: I'm hearing a loud banging noise.

OPERATOR: Okay I will ah, I, I'm gonna let them know if there's a chance if it's the police but I don't know for sure.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Ah so I would, I would stay behind a locked door if you can stay behind (inaudible) the locked doors that's, that's even better.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: If I know for, if I find out for sure that that is the police I will tell you, I don't know for sure right now. Um, so we're gonna treat it as if it's not.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: Um, I guess in terms of do the safest thing you possibly can, okay. If you can find a place to sit down, if you can find a place you can, you can take some, some deep breaths is often helpful in just making it (inaudible) things clearly.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: But I understand you've got other folks to take care of right now.

CALLER: (loud noise) He's shooting again. (loud noise) He's shooting again.
